



How to achieve the look your after by using our base stain and aquatop system

- On bare wood lightly sand with a fine grade abrasive paper in the direction of the grain, brush down with a dry brush or vacuum to remove all dust, apply a 1 coat of the base stain.
- Lightly sand again- dust down apply at least 2 coats of aquatop and allowing 4 hours between coats. The more coats of aquatop you apply the darker your window will become until you achieve your desired shade.

Maintenance on base stains and aquatop systems

- We recommend you apply aquatop at least every 2 years to retain maximum protection.
- If regular maintenance is delayed or some other damage has occurred- follow the following steps:
- Lightly sand down your windows and doors in the direction of the grain. If there are minor flakings in an area of the top coat- abrade the area with a fine grade abrasive paper to remove unsound coating and feather out to a smooth finish.
- Remove all dust particles with a dry brush and damp cloth- allow to dry thoroughly.
- Apply at least 2 coats of aquatop and allow 4 hours between coats.
- The number of top coats and frequency of maintenance depends on the weathering and erosions in your area.

Maintenance of our paint system

- We recommend you paint your windows and doors at least every 4 years, this may be required more frequently depending on exposure to weather conditions and Ultra Violet Lights.

- Lightly sand down in the direction of the grain with a fine grade abrasive paper, dust down with a dry brush and a damp cloth.
- Allow to dry thoroughly before applying finish coat.
- Paint can be applied directly from the tub or thinned between 5%-10% with water which will improve the flow particularly in warmer weather.
- Always allow at least 4 hours between coats.
- The number of coats and frequency of maintenance depends on the weathering and erosion in your area

Cleaning of brushes

- For best results wash out brushes with a mild detergent solution, and then rinse thoroughly with clean water
